Health Homes

- ❖ A new Medicaid state plan option, effective January 2011
- ❖ For Medicaid enrollees with
 - ✓ two or more chronic conditions,
 - ✓ one condition and the risk of developing another, or
 - ✓ at least one serious and persistent mental health condition

Health Homes

- ❖ Provide 90% FMAP for two years for health home related services of
 - ✓ Comprehensive care management
 - ✓ Care coordination and health promotion
 - ✓ Comprehensive transitional care
 - ✓ Referral to community and support services
 - ✓ Use of HIT to link services

Health Homes

- ❖ Beneficiaries choose the provider, team of health professionals or health team to act as the individual's health home

Health Homes

- ❖ Center for Medicaid, CHIP, and Survey & Certification (CMCS) will issue regulations, State Medicaid Director letter and state plan pre-print
