

## NASHP ABCD Screening Academy Preliminary Ohio Measurement Plan

Ohio has developed a control chart using Medicaid claims data that assesses the number of screening claims (96110 and 96111) for children at one and two years of age. We plan on tracking data quarterly and annotating the chart to assess how changes have impacted screening and its documentation. We are also discussing chart review to measure and analyze data at the individual practice level and compare this with claims data, as a way to confirm the validity of these methods. In addition, we are exploring how to track referrals using Help-Me-Grow data.

We are using the preliminary Numerator & Denominator definitions below:

### Measure of the Percent of Children Screened Using Medicaid CLAIMS DATA:

**Numerator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 13 months of age during the quarter for whom a 96110 claim of developmental screening was received *at any time* since birth and who had at least one primary care visit **X 100**

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**Denominator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 13 months of age during that quarter and who had at least one primary care visit

**Numerator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 26 months of age during the quarter for whom a 96110 claim of developmental screening was received at any time since 12 months of age and who has had one primary care visit since 12 months of age **X 100**

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**Denominator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 26 months of age during that quarter and who had at least one primary care visit since 12 months of age

**Numerator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 13 months of age during the quarter for whom a 96111 claim of developmental screening was received *at any time* since birth and who had at least one primary care visit since birth **X 100**

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**Denominator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 12 months of age during that quarter and who had at least one primary care visit since birth

**Numerator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 26 months of age during the quarter for whom a 96111 claim of developmental screening was received at any time since 12 months of age and who had at least one primary care visit since 12 months of age **X 100**

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**Denominator:** Number of enrolled children who reached 26 months of age during that quarter and who had at least one primary care visit since 12 months of age
